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1- Sand and water activities are relaxing and stress reducing. Children tend to calm down while running sand through their fingers or pouring from one container to another.

2- Labeled shelves help children clean up and organize the blocks by matching their shapes.

3- Plants create a homey atmosphere in the classroom and introduce children to the science of living things.

4- All children need an opportunity to engage in dramatic play. This helps build life skills.

5- Art materials encourage the development of a variety of skills. It allows children to practice important fine motor skills and learn to be creative using lines, shapes and colors.

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
